Mr Lionel Yee Woon Chin, 46, is the Second Solicitor-General at the Attorney-General's Chambers.

Mr Yee graduated with a Bachelor of Arts in Law degree from the University of Cambridge, United Kingdom in 1988 on a Public Service Commission Overseas Merit Scholarship. He was admitted as an advocate and solicitor of the Supreme Court of Singapore in 1993.
