Dear *Mr President,*

1. I am pleased to accept the appointment to the office of Prime Minister of Singapore.

2. The Swearing-in Ceremony will take place on 15 May 2024, 8 pm, at the Istana lawn. Upon my formal appointment at the Swearing-in Ceremony, I will formally advise that, in accordance with Article 25(1) of the Constitution, the following Members of Parliament be appointed as Ministers with effect from 15 May 2024.
